COMPETITION GUIDELINES

DATE

The date of the Women's Festival Month Competition will be on July 26-28, 2017.

VENUE

The competitions venue will be at the Harrison Plaza Mall, F.B. Harrison St. Manila.

EVENTS

The Women's Competition events are as follows:

A. Match category

PRE-TEEN (10-13 yr. old)

1. Class A : 31-34 kg.
2. Class B : 34-37 kg.
3. Class C : 37-40 kg.
4. Class D : 40-43 kg.

JUNIOR (14-16 yr. old)

- Class A : 39-43 kg.
- Class B : 43-47 kg.
- Class C : 47-51 kg.
- Class D : 51-55 kg.

SENIOR (17-25 yr. old)

- Class A : 45-50 kg.
- Class B : 50-55 kg.
- Class C : 55-60 kg.
- Class D : 60-65 kg.

B. Artistic Category

1. Tunggal Only

ENTRIES

- a) There are three (3) Division of entries
 1. Pre Teen Division age ranges from 10 to 13 yr old.
 2. Junior Division age ranges from 14-16 yr old.
 3. Senior Division age ranges from 17 to 25 yr old.
- b) Each participating LGU or chapter may enter one athlete per weight category.
- c) On Line registration of athlete is a must.
- d) Send in the official entries through email add: kiramdatuabdilnasser@gmail.com
- e) Deadline of submission of entries is on/or before 16th July 2017.
- f) During technical meeting Coach may be allowed to change entry by name of a competitor

WEIGH-IN

- a) Athletes weigh-in is carried out once only during competition proper and must be witnessed by coaches from both teams.
- b) After conducting the official weigh-in of the athletes, it is mandatory for the weigh-in staff and coaches of both teams to sign the weigh-in form.
- c) If one of the coach failed to endorse or sign the form the weigh-in will remained valid.
- d) No tolerance of weight. Over and underweight athlete is automatically disqualified to compete.

MEDICAL CHECK UP

- a) It is mandatory to all competitors to comply Medical Letters/Certificates from their Doctors of which will signify that they are FIT TO COMPETE.
- b) Competitors failed to show Medical Certification before the official weigh-in is conducted will be disqualified from the competitions.
- c) Medical certification/letters must be submitted on or before the Team Managers Meeting will take place.

TEAM MANAGERS TECHNICAL MEETINGS and DRAW LOTS

- a) There shall be a Team Managers Technical Meeting with the Referees-Jurors Council at a designated venue and followed with the draw lots of competitors entries.
- b) Information of the time, date and venue of the meetings will be announced upon arrival of the participating team.

COMPETITIONS RULES

Match/Tanding

- a) Each competing class category should be joined by at least two (2) competitors who eventually meet at the final round.
- b) A re-weighing is required to be conducted for every competitor fifteen (15) minutes prior the match begins for every weight category.
- c) Competitor found to be under or overweight after the reweight-in is done he/she will be automatically disqualified to compete anymore.
- d) Strictly no claims and protest will be entertained five (5) minutes after the result of winner is declared by a referee.

e) Claims and protest can be made only at the Jury of Appeal by the Team Manager in writing along with Php 5,000.00 protest money.

f) Result of the protest that will be declare after a thorough reviewed and investigation by the Jury of Appeal is irrevocable and absolutely final.

Tunggal and Regu

a) When a Tunggal and Regu participated by more than seven (7) participants, a pool system will be arranged into two (2) pools division for an elimination round.

b) A two (2) pools division of contestants will be determined at a Technical Meetings and Draw Lots of the Team Managers and Coaches.

c) Three ((3) of the contestants with the highest scores from each pool division will proceed to final round.

d) An inspection of weapons will be done at a designated place before the Tunggal and Ganda competitions.

REFEREES / JURORS

a) The competitions will be conducted by an accredited Referees & Jurors holding an International or National / Local Federation certificate.

b) Participating LGU or Chapter may nominate one referee / juror to conduct the competitions fair and smooth upon confirmation by the PHILSILAT Technical Delegates.

c) A refresher course may be conducted by PHILSILAT Technical Delegates prior with the competition proper.

d) Referees/Jurors who are officially invited to officiate the competitions may arrive one day before the competitions.

GENERAL MATTERS

Any matters arises during competition proper which is not stated and stipulated herein the competitions system is subject to the final decision of the tournament Director and the jury of Appeal.
